TIM's CLUBe generally operates on a three-strikes-you're-out basis. However, **the rules in bold are zero-tolerance**. Breaking the zero-tolerance rules will result in immediate removal from the program.

If a resident is removed from the program, they are required to leave the TC property immediately. In this event, the TC Team is authorized to pack the resident's belongings; the resident must contact the Program Director within 10 days to arrange retrieval of their belongings. Belongings not retrieved will be donated or discarded. Removal from the program, or choosing to leave before completion of the six month program, will result in forfeiture of the sobriety deposit.

"Staff" refers to the Program Director, Administrator, and Volunteer Coordinator. The "TC Team" refers to staff and trained volunteers. "Resident" refers to anyone living in a TIM's CLUBe residence (other than the TC team).

Resider	nts are to take any prescribed medications as directed by a physician; improper use or
refusal	to take prescribed medications will result in immediate termination from the program
Resider	nts are not to take medications on the Restricted Medications List and must keep
healtho	care professionals advised of medications not allowed at TIM's CLUBe
	nts will keep the Program Director and Administrator informed of changes to their bed medications as well as any over-the-counter medications or supplements taken
Resider out	its must store medications in the back of a high drawer, no medications are to be sitting
Resider that fac	its who come to TC from treatment must complete all out-patient treatment advised by cility
Resider	nts will attend at least one church service per week at a church approved by the Program
Directo	r, and provide a photo to the Program Director and Mentor
Resider	its will attend at least one recovery program per week and fully participate (Celebrate
Recove	ry highly recommended) and provide a photo to the Program Director and Mentor
Resider	nts will have a sponsor from the recovery program
Resider	its will attend TIM's CLUBe weekly Bible study on Friday evenings and arrange work
schedu	lles around this meeting

	Residents consent to the TC team communicating and sharing information with parole and
	probation officers
	All residents must be gainfully employed within the first two weeks
	Residents on disability are allowed, only if disability payments have started before coming to
	TC; residents who are on disability will need to volunteer 15 hours per week
	Sobriety deposit (\$200) and the first \$200 of program fees are to be paid before moving in;
	Sobriety deposit will be returned upon successful completion of the six-month program and
	transitioning out of the residence
	Residents will pay weekly program fees before purchasing non-necessities (ie phone, vehicle)
	Residents must return to the recovery house by curfew and remain in the house until 5:00 am
	(starting curfew is 6:30 pm and will be reviewed regularly)
	Failure to return to the recovery house by midnight is zero-tolerance
	Residents will maintain a clean and tidy bedroom (bed made daily) and participate in upkeep of
	the residence (inside and out); rooms will be monitored for excessive possessions; no picking up
	furniture from the curb
	Residents must consent to searches of their person and property at any time by the TC Team
	The Program Director must be given access (spare key or combination) to any locked containers
	within the resident's possession
	Residents who smoke are to do so only outdoors and place stubs in a proper receptacle
	Residents obtain their own food, toiletries, and laundry supplies; household cleaning products and
	bedding are provided by TC
	Residents are not to conduct any business out of the residence that would bring customers to
	the residence
	Residents are not to hire out to have their chores done, the only exception is lawn care and snow removal may be hired out to another resident
	Residents are not to associate with people who are actively using alcohol or illegal drugs;
	anyone in possession or under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs is not allowed at any
	TC property
	Residents are not permitted to have guests (other than their minor child) in bedrooms; all
	guests must leave the residence by 9:00 PM
	No public displays of affection
	Residents are responsible for oversight and the behavior of their guests and children while visiting
	Any guest that displays problematic behavior or makes residents uncomfortable may be barred
	from visiting
	Guests or minor children on a medication from the Restricted Medications List are not
	allowed to bring those medications on the property (includes Ritalin and Adderall)
	Residents must inform the staff before bringing any minor (child under the age of 18) onto TC
	property
	Before any minor enters a TC house, a Child Liability Waiver must be signed by the child's
	legal guardian
	Children age 10 and under are allowed to stay in a TC house, with their parent, up to 3 nights per
	week
	Residents must be present with their children who are in a TC house at all times (no leaving
	children in the house without you, even for a short amount of time)
	Children at a TC house are not permitted in bedrooms other than their parent's
	Residents are responsible for oversight of their children any time they are on TC property; no
	babysitting is permitted by staff, volunteers, other residents, or outside babysitters (unless
	childcare is provided at Friday night Bible Studies)
	Residents must be present anytime their child is provided a ride by a TC staff or volunteer;
	residents are responsible to know and obey age-appropriate car seat laws
-	Any minor children who visit TC houses must be up-to-date with required age-appropriate
	vaccinations

	Residents must not engage in any illegal activity, including breaking a No-Contact Order,
	driving without a license / insurance, and gang activity / affiliation
	Residents are allowed one vehicle at the residence; all vehicles at TC properties must be registered
	and insured; residents are not allowed to drive without a valid license and insurance
	Residents must not possess, use, or transport weapons (firearms, knives, projectiles, explosives,
	etc)
	Residents must not possess pornography, including visiting pornographic websites
	Residents are not to gamble or enter a casino
	Residents are not to download illegal / copyrighted content (ie bootleg movies) Including but
	not limited to: Popcorn Time, Vuze, Frostwire, Kodi, Brave, Opera, Showbox, Torrent, Peer to Peer
	Residents must not engage in physical or verbal altercations with the TC team or other
	residents
	Residents must not steal from other residents or TC team members
	Residents must not vandalize the property of TIM's CLUBe, the TC team, or other residents
	Residents will not make false statements to any of the TC team
	Residents are prohibited from physical or romantic relationships with another resident, any
	staff person, or any volunteer
	Residents are prohibited from being alone with a volunteer of a different gender
	Disrespectful conduct toward the TC team will not be tolerated, including a disruptive
	attitude or disturbing the function of the program; continued issues will result in removal
	from the program
	Residents will be required to work at least two hours at any CLUBe-wide events, such as
	fundraising events
	Residents must provide the Program Director and Administrator with their personal phone
	number, and make them aware of any changes
	Any resident disputes requiring mediation will be brought to the Program Director
	Residents who question or disagree with any actions of the Program Director may appeal to the
	Board of Directors
	Tim's Clube is not responsible for any lost or stolen items
	Failure to comply with zero-tolerance rules will result in immediate removal from the
	recovery house property, removal from the program, and forfeiture of the resident's sobriety
	deposit. In this event, the TC Team is authorized to pack the resident's belongings and the
	resident must contact the Program Director within 10 days to arrange retrieval of their
